1. Embroidery - inc. all types of embroidery, canvas work etc.
2. Fabric craft - can include dressmaking, patchwork, toy making, quilting, felting, silk painting etc.
3. Yarn craft - includes knitting, lace making, crochet, etc.
4. Hard craft - can include basket making, paper craft inc card making, woodwork, hand thrown pottery, jewellery, etc.
5. A photograph interpreting the 'Celebrations' theme - max size, including mount 15" (38cm) x 15" (38cm).
6. A painting - any medium - mounted - max. size, including mount 18" (45.7cm) x 18" (45.7cm).
7. Beginners - For competitors who have never previously won with any item in the Handicraft Section.

9. A 'Celebration' cake.

21. 4 different herbs in a clear untinted glass container.
22. 4 plums - with stalks.
23. 3 apples - eating.
24. 3 apples - cooking.
25. 4 tomatoes.
26. 6 runner beans.
27. 4 onions from sets (tops tied).
28. 3 beetroots (leave 3" of stem).
29. 3 potatoes.
30. A cucumber.
31. 3 courgettes.
32. 6 sweet peas.
33. 3 roses.
34. 4 dahlias.
35. 5 different garden flowers in water with their foliage (no shrub Flowers).
36. 6 pansies.
37. Pot plant grown for foliage - not previously shown - owned for at least 3 months
38. Flowering pot plant - not previously shown - owned for at least 3 months
39. A trio of vegetables or fruit (3 of each kind) on a tray - not to exceed 18" (45.7cm) x 12" (30.5cm). Parsley may be used to dress the exhibit.
40. 3 chrysanthemums.

CHILDREN'S SECTION

41. Under fives - A vegetable animal.
42. 6 - 10 years old - A decorated party hat.
43. 12 years old and under - "I made it myself", this could be any item of craft (such as making cards), cookery, photography .. and lots more.
